Chamber Seeks Candidates for Board of Directors

Three Wall-Badlands Area Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors terms will expire the end of April 2021. The Nominating Committee, appointed by the Chamber Board President, has selected a slate of candidates to run for election. Those nominated are Bobby Dartt, Hope Dennis, and Anne Posley.

At-Large nominations must be brought to the Nominating Committee prior to March 25. At-Large nominations require a petition, bearing the signatures of at least fifteen members qualified to vote. Petitions are available in the Chamber Office.

The election for the Chamber Board of Directors will be held by secret ballot at the Annual Meeting. The Nominating Committee will distribute one paper ballot per eligible voting Chamber member. The committee will gather ballots and tally results, which will be announced before the meeting adjourns. Those elected at the Annual Meeting will take office May 1.

Wall-Badlands Area Chamber of Commerce Meeting Minutes February 8, 2021 Virtual Luncheon Zoom

Wall-Badlands Area Chamber of Commerce Board President Dustin Curr called the meeting to order at 12:02 PM and announced the Chamber Board has decided to hold Chamber Luncheons virtually due to restrictions some Chamber Member Businesses have regarding staff attending meetings in person.

Anne Jo Spotted Bear moved to approve meeting minutes from the January Chamber Luncheon. Second made by Dawn Hilgenkamp. Motion carried. Kim Handcock moved to approve the Treasurer's Report. Second made by Anne Jo Spotted Bear. Motion carried. Dustin announced upcoming events in the Wall Community.

Nomination Committee: Kim Handcock: According to Chamber Bylaws Article IV Section IV, the Chamber Board President will appoint a Nominating Committee who will present a slate of candidates for the Chamber Board at the February Membership Luncheon; the Committee shall nominate at least one person for each vacancy on the Board. The Committee has nominated Hope Dennis, Anne Posley, and Bobbi Dartt to run for the Chamber Board of Directors. At-Large Nomination Petitions can be picked up from the Chamber Office and must be returned to the Chamber Office prior to March 25. The election for the Board will be held at the Chamber's Annual Meeting by secret ballot. Those elected to the Board shall take office on May 1.

Wall-Badlands Area Chamber of Commerce: Kelsey Clark: The Chamber will be hosting a Cracker Barrel on February 11; District 27 & District 30 Legislators will be present to share an update and answer questions about the 2021 Legislative Session. The Chamber received \$4,035 from the South Dakota Non-Profit Grant. The Chamber Annual Meeting will be held on Thursday, April 22. This will be an abbreviated meeting with no banquet or guest speaker.

Wall Economic Development: Mary Williams: The Agritourism Community Hub is up and going and has hired a coach; if you would like to participate you can apply by March 1. Leadership classes are going well and the 3rd class will be held tonight with the topic of Roles and Responsibilities of a Board Member. Industrial Park plans are moving forward and the committee has received approval from the City Council to move ahead with environmental studies. WEDC would like to become the only Certified Industrial Park in western South Dakota.

Minuteman Missile NHS: Kelsey Clark reporting for Jeanne Berry: Following the Federal Mask Mandate, masks will be required in the Visitor Center and on Delta-01 tours. Seasonal Summer hiring is being finalized. MMNHS is continuing with winter hours of operation; Visitor Center is open Tuesday-Sunday 8 AM – 4 PM, Delta-09 Missile Silo is open Tuesday-Saturday 9 AM – 3 PM, and Delta-01 Launch Control topside tours are offered Wednesday-Saturday at 1 PM and 2 PM.

Rodeo Booster Club: Mary Williams: 8 Wall High School Rodeo athletes participated in the 20X Rodeo during the Black Hills Stock Show; 5 athletes placed in their events. 2021 rodeo dates; 4-H Rodeo, May 30; Regional High School Rodeo, June 4-6; PRCA Rodeos, July 8-10. The PRCA Rodeo will include entertainment by The One Arm Bandit. New to the PRCA Rodeo this year will be Steer Tripping which will be held at 8 AM on Thursday, July 8. Rode Slack will follow Steer Tripping Thursday morning and will also be held Thursday evening and Friday morning; Rodeo Performances will be Friday and Saturday evening.

Wall School: Dan Baldwin: Mid-quarter was last week; report cards were sent out and Parent/ Teacher Conferences were held. Winter sports are wrapping up. At this month's School Board meeting Board Members will be discussing the Powerhouse use and needs as well as Capital Outlay and what will be the best investments. The School has received applications for a 6-12 Principle.

West River Electric: Dawn Hilgenkamp: WREA offices are open to the public. Monies typically spent for Youth Tours in D.C. will be used for 2- \$1,000 scholarships for High School Juniors this year. To apply, students must write a 500-word essay about how COVID has affected their life.

First Interstate Bank: Janet Lurz: The bank lobby is now open from 10 AM until 3 PM. With no other business, Anne Jo Spotted Bear moved to adjourn the meeting. Second by Kim Handcock. Motion Carried. Meeting was adjourned at 12:23 PM.
