November 8, 2021

Noon Luncheon

Wall-Badlands Area Chamber of Commerce Board President Dustin Curr called the meeting to order at 12:06 PM and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Anne Jo Spotted Bear moved to approve meeting minutes from the October Chamber Luncheon. Second made by Cindy Hauk. Motion carried. Cindy Hauk moved to approve the Treasurer's Report. Second made by Melanie Shull. Motion carried. Dustin announced upcoming events in the Wall Community.

Wall-Badlands Area Chamber of Commerce: Kelsey Clark: The Chamber Holiday Sweepstakes is back! This program will offer a total of \$2,000 in WALL BUCK\$ prizes for those who shop local November 18-January 3; businesses interested in participating can contact the Chamber office to receive supplies. The Chamber Retail Committee Pancake Supper will be held on Wednesday, December 8 at Wall Drug; supper will begin at 5 PM and attendees can enter for a chance to win WALL BUCK\$. The Chamber will be hosting 'A Badlands Country Christmas' on Wednesday, December 15; social hour will start at 5:30 PM, dinner served at roughly 6:15 PM, and a Christmas performance by Orion and Stacy Potter at 6:30 PM. The Chamber will now be offering a \$100 WALL BUCK\$ drawing at each Chamber Luncheon for Chamber Members who attend the luncheons; all Chamber members will be entered into the drawing but must be present at the luncheon to win-the drawing will be a rolling jack pot.

City Of Wall: Rick Husted: At the City Council Meeting on November 4, Marty Huether resigned from the position of Mayor. Rick thanked Marty Huether for his leadership, great dedication and service to the citizens and City of Wall, as Mayor, for the past 7 years. Rick will fill in as Mayor; the City Council can appoint someone else to the position if they choose. The city is working on the 2022 budget; the 2021 budget was \$3.2 million but this coming year will be roughly \$8.6 million. Petitions to run for Mayor and 3 Council positions can be taken out in January; petitions will be due the end of February and the city election will be in April.

Wall Economic Development: Liliya Stone: WEDC received a Workforce Marketing Campaign Grant from SD GOED; the campaign will start in early 2022 and will target employees in trade industries. Leadership classes will begin in January; there will be 6 class sessions and WEDC is looking for 15 people to participate. The WEDC Annual Meeting will be November 17 and the guest speaker will be Joe Fiala. On November 22, the Winter Holidays Around the World event will be held at the school; the event will highlight various winter holidays and have a Native American bead workshop. The Parade of Lights will be held on December 2, with a Winter Dance following in the Wall Community Center.

Wall Ambulance Service: Carrie Schell: The Ambulance service will be offering additional training classes about protocols and rules required for EMTs and Paramedics; first responders and community members interested in joining the ambulance services are also invited to attend. The Ambulance Board is looking for one individual to fill in on the Board until the next election. At the next election 3 board positions will be available. The Ambulance is looking for more drivers, EMT's, and Paramedics. The Wall Fire Department is in crucial need for volunteers to serve in the department; currently the department has 15 volunteers and have to have at least 15 to be state certified.

Country Cupboard Food Pantry: Carol Hodge: Carol thanked the Chamber for announcing when the Food Pantry is open on the weekly KBHB radio report. The Food Pantry is once again raising money for Thanksgiving baskets that will be given out during November.

Badlands Quilter: Carol Hodge: Soldier quilts will be given out during the Wall School Veteran's Day Program; this is an ongoing project for the group. This year the Badlands Quilters delivered 10 quilts to veterans who reside at Fort Meade.

Rodeo Booster Club: Dawn Hilgenkamp: The Rodeo Fund Raising Auction was held on October 16 and the club raised over \$10,000. The High School Rodeo team also raised money for their events.

Wall School District: Dr. Pandi Pittman: The 1st Quarter of the '21-'22 school year has wrapped up. Football and volleyball seasons have concluded and activities are slow for the moment. A Comprehensive Needs Assessment is being completed by collecting data to develop an action plan to find areas to be improved upon; parents should watch for a survey that will be sent out. A meeting was held with the school building committee and started the process to design a master plan for the school buildings and replacing some of the facilities at the powerhouse as well as expanding CTE opportunities. The school is selling their skid steer by sealed bids; bids must be returned to the school before the November school board meeting. A Veterans Day Program will be held at the school on November 16.

West River Electric: Dawn Hilgenkamp: Scholarships for High School seniors are now available and due January 17; applications are available online. WREA is running a second round of Operation Round Up; applications are due February 1 and can be found online.

Golden West: Jody Bielmaier: Golden West customers can register to win up to \$500 for the customer appreciation; customers must register before December 10. Golden West offices will be Close November 11 and November 25; tech support and repair services will still be available.

First Interstate Bank: Melanie Shull: the 3rd Annual Festival of Trees will be held on November 19. The program benefits the Greater Wall Fund which helps fund projects in the Wall Community. This year there are 14 trees and 17 wreaths auctioned off at the event as well as various silent auction items. Social hour for the event will begin at 5:30 PM and the auction will start at roughly 6:15 PM.

4th Ave. Floral: Cindy Hauk: November 8-13 is Caring Rose Week; cans of food and money collected during the promotion will be donated to the Country Cupboard Food Pantry.

Dustin Curr introduced new Chamber member, Bill Cummings from Whispering Pines Bed & Breakfast Outfitters.

The winner of the \$100 WALL BUCK\$ for attending the luncheon is First Lutheran Church, accepted by Carol Hodge.

With no other business, Jody Bielmaier moved to adjourn the meeting. Second made by Ron Dinger. Motion Carried. There will be no Chamber Luncheon in December.
