

The U.S. Department of Labor announced the new 2021 minimum wage. The minimum wage is annually adjusted by any increase in cost of living in conjunction with the Consumer Price Index.

#### **NON-TIPPED EMPLOYEES**

Beginning Jan. 1, 2021, the minimum wage for non-tipped employees in South Dakota will be \$9.45/hour. (2020 - MW \$9.30/hour)

#### TIP CREDIT (TIPPED EMPLOYEÉS)

Beginning Jan. 1, 2021, the hourly minimum wage for tipped employees will be no less than \$4.725/hour. (2020- MW \$4.65/hour)

Second made by Liliya Stone. Motion carried. Jody Bielmaier moved to approve the Treasurer's Report. Second made by Dawn Hilgenkamp. Motion carried. Dustin announced upcoming events in the Wall community.

Wall-Badlands Area Chamber of Commerce: Kelsey Clark: The Chamber Holiday Sweepstakes is back! This program will offer WALL BUCK\$ as prizes for those who buy local Monday, November 16 through Thursday, December 31; any businesses interested in participating can contact the Chamber office to receive supplies. Each year the Chamber purchases a 2-page ad in the South Dakota Vacation Guide; Chamber Members are invited to partner with the Chamber and be included in the ad. Cost to participate in \$300. The South Dakota Governor's Conference on Tourism will be held January 20-21, in Pierre. The conference will be a hybrid of limited in-person attendance as well as a virtual option.

**Wall-Badlands Area Chamber of Commerce Retail Committee:** Jenny Patterson: The Retail Committee has decided to cancel the Annual Pancake Supper. The Committee will work with WEDC and Creative Community Concepts to host Santa Claus in the Wall Community Center after the Parade of Lights. Watch for more updates.

**Wall Economic Development:** Liliya Stone: The new WEDC High School board member is Sierra Hilgenkamp. Wall Economic Development's 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting will be held on November 18 in the Wall Community Center; Elevate Rapid City CEO Tom Johnson will be the guest speaker. The Parade of Lights will be held on December 10, please RSVP if you are interested in participating. WEDC is working with the Chamber Retail Committee and Creative Community Concepts to safely host Santa Claus in the Wall Community Center after the Parade of Lights.

**Black Hills & Badlands Tourism Association:** Hayli Hull: The 2021 SDVG is in production; there has been great participation and ad renewal for 2021. BH&B will be representing the Black Hills & Badlands region at the National Tour Association gathering, the Wall-Badlands Area Chamber is the only community participating in the 2-page advertising piece that will be given to tour operators.

**Rodeo Booster Club:** Dawn Hilgenkamp: The next rodeo meeting will be November 11 at 5:30 PM. Plans are moving forward for the PRCA Rodeo to be held next summer during the Wall Celebration. Five local students have qualified to participate in the 20X rodeo during the Black Hills Stock Show.

**Wall School District:** Dan Baldwin: The 1<sup>st</sup> quarter has ended and student enrollment is up with 276 total kids. Junior High girls' basketball and Junior High wrestling has started. Live Ticket is streaming as many sporting events as possible. A community informational meeting to discuss ALICE protocols will be held November 24. The school board is focusing on the 5-year capital outlay plan which will decide where to spend money over the years.

**Golden West:** Jody Bielmaier: On Oct 27, 2020 Governor Kristi Noem announced the launch of K-12 Connect, a program to provide internet service at no cost to eligible K-12 students in their home for the remainder of the 2020-21 school year. The K-12 Connect is a partnership of the South Dakota Governor's Office, Bureau of Information and Telecommunications, Department of Education, and participating telecommunications companies. Golden West is excited to be a participating telecommunications provider in this great program. Golden West employees will not be working Veteran's Day, November 11<sup>th</sup> or Thanksgiving Day, November 26<sup>th</sup>. While general services will not be available these days by phone, Golden West Help Desk and Repair Service is available 24x7 at 1-855-888-7777.
