September 12, 2023

Noon Luncheon

Wall-Badlands Area Chamber of Commerce Board President Gina Kraut called the meeting to order at 12:01 PM and Liliya Stone led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Susie Radigan-Kjerstad moved to approve meeting minutes from the August Chamber Luncheon. Second made by Cindy Hauk. Motion carried. Dawn Hilgenkamp moved to approve the Treasurer's Report. Second made by Anne Jo Spotted Bear. Motion carried.

Wall-Badlands Area Chamber of Commerce: Katie Bruce: The Wall Craft show is November 4th and the VFW will be hosting turkey bingo again this year. Anyone who would like to register for a table should contact the Chamber. The Chamber will be working with Economic Development to celebrate the opening of the airport also in November.

<u>City Of Wall:</u> Mayor Williams: Echo Valley construction is on schedule and lots are available through Cheyenne McGriff with ReMax. There will be a new house on lot 2 on Kelly Ave being built. The Comprehensive plan was given its annual review at the last city council meeting. Personnel and budget committees will be meeting in the coming month. Planning and Zoning will be meeting Sept 25th at 9:30. There is a 10-minute time slot for public comment and anyone is welcome to attend. They will be re-writing the zoning ordinance at this meeting.

Wall Airport: Travis Hirshey- Mead & Hunt: Travis is the assistant project manager at the airport. Western Construction is managing the project and is doing a great job. Travis gave a history of the airport. An overview of the current updates being made and showed the future of the airport. Discussion was held on the number of planes that land at our airport, sometimes as many as 8 a day. The pilot's lounge is a draw to our airport and a great asset. Travis, Dave Jedlicka, and Dale Patterson answered questions and educated us on where the funding for the airport comes from. The city pays a very small percentage of the updates at the airport, most coming from GA and FFA funds.

Wall Economic Development: Dawn Hilgenkamp: Kendall is attending the Fuel the Growth conference in Rapid City. Dawn passed out a flyer on a Build Dakota Resources meeting that will be held October 13th. This program helps business owners send their employees to classes at technical schools in return for a time commitment from the individual. Kendall will be attending the EDPA conference in Brookings the 19th & 20th. There has been additional interest in industrial park lots. The next WEDC board meeting is Sept 27th at 6pm.

Rodeo Booster Club: Dawn Hilgenkamp: They will be holding an appreciation auction October 14th at the golf course at 7pm. Donations can be dropped off to Dawn at WREA.

West River Electric: Dawn Hilgenkamp: Their annual appreciation day will be in Rapid City Sept 22nd from 11am-7pm and they will be serving hamburgers and hotdogs. WREA annual meeting is October 7th. Registration is at 9am and meeting will start at 10. There are 3 directors up for election, two are uncontested but one spot has 3 people running. There is a job opening in Rapid City office and the deadline to apply is October 24th.

Wall in the Fall: DeAnna Kammerer: Thank you to everyone for supporting the Scavengers Journey. DeAnna and Cindy are hosting Harvest Fest Days September 22-23. Both businesses will be open 9-4 those days and they will have vendors at their locations. If anyone would like to be included, please contact DeAnna, Cindy or the Chamber.

Wheelin to Wall: Charon Geigle: 7th annual Wheelin to Wall is Sept 23 & 24. They will be biking through the badlands and the grasslands on Saturday and Sunday is a ride through the Cheyenne river basin and this will be a poker run. Saturday night they will have the peddle parade of lights sponsored by Black Hills Federal Credit Union with a smore party afterwards at Stay Wall. Volunteers are needed for the crossing the streets safely. They have 87 people signed up to date.

Other: Steven Edoff: Tomorrow the bank will close at noon for their annual volunteer day. Thank you to everyone who came out to the Neighbors Feeding Neighbors event, all the money was donated to the Angel Program. Festival of Trees will be November 17th.

Lillian Helms-Country Cupboard Food Pantry: Lillian thanked the Chamber for their donation to the food pantry and advised they have switched to their fall hours. They are also doing their backpack program again this year. Last year they had 2 participants, this year they have 14. This program provides food for children on the weekends and snacks for during their school day.
